

MINUTES
WATERLOO HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
SPECIAL MEETING - 4:00 P.M. MAY 18, 2001
104 PROSPECT AVENUE- SPECIAL MOBILE MEETING

Chairman Levi called the special meeting of the Waterloo Historic Preservation Commission to order at 4:00 p.m. Members present were: Aronson, Durbahn, Levi, Leonhart, and Peterson. Sharon Smith, owner of 104 Prospect was present from the public and Noel Anderson and Terry Malone were present from the City.

Aronson motioned to approve the Agenda as submitted. Peterson seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously.

Durbahn motioned to approve the Agenda and Peterson seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

There were no reports from Main Street or Silos and Smokestacks.

Mrs. Smith requested a Certificate of Appropriateness to replace the existing car siding with cedar siding on her enclosed porch in the rear. Levi gave an oral report highlighting the wood siding on surrounding properties. It was recommended by the Commission that a wide trim cedar siding be used to match the surroundings and to remain consistent with past practice, and that the horizontal and vertical patterns remain the same with the new application of siding.

Peterson motioned to approve the request based on the Commission recommendations and Aronson seconded. The motion was approved unanimously. With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:15 p.m.
