WATERLOO HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING – 4:30 P.M. – TUESDAY, JULY 16, 2002
MOLLENHOFF CONFERENCE ROOM – 2ND FLOOR CITY HALL

Chairperson Levi started the discussion at the regularly scheduled meeting of the Waterloo Historic Preservation Commission at 4:35 p.m.

Members present were: Levi, Pearson, Etheredge, and Aronson. Also present was Mr. Price of 1202 Independence Avenue and staff members Noel Anderson and Melissa Edsill.

Chairperson Levi started the meeting by noting the Commission was unable to achieve a quorum, therefore, no items would receive official action at this gathering.

There was not a report for this month from Main Street Waterloo or Silos and Smokestacks.

The commission decided to move to the discussion of 1202 Independence Avenue because Mr. Price was there to discuss the changes to the deck with the Commission. Mr. Price indicated he had constructed a fence to obscure the view of deck from Independence Avenue as well as Arizona Street. The commission commented that they would like this issue resolved. The Commission also noted they would need to see the plan for changes proposed for the deck.

The commission continued with the request to have the Historic Preservation Commission be a sponsor of the Old House Fair. Due to the fact that there was not a quorum present, the Commission took no action with regards to this request and requested it be added to next month's agenda for official approval. Some discussion ensued about what activities would be going on during the event and which commission members would be able to be present and participate.

The Commission moved to the discussion of the renovations of East High. A discussion took place questioning whether the new windows in the old building were part of the approval from the Commission when they were presented the Phase I renovation plans. The Commission directed staff to look into the minutes from that meeting and the permit that was issued for the new windows.

Levi adjourned the meeting at 4:55 P.M.
