

NURSES MONTH MAYORAL PROCLAMATION

Whereas, registered nurses in the United States constitute our nation's largest health care profession, and

Whereas, the depth and breadth of the registered nursing profession meets the different and emerging health care needs of the American population in a wide range of settings, including the frontline of the pandemic, and

Whereas, the American Nurses Association, as the voice for registered nurses in this country, is working to chart a new course for a healthy nation that relies on increasing access to primary and preventive health care, and better utilization of all our nation's registered nursing resources, and

Whereas, professional nursing is an indispensable component of the safety and quality of care of hospitalized and non-hospitalized patients, and

- a. Permission to utilize a portion of the Bishop Park Fishing Pier for May 25th 2024 starting at 8 am to 12 pm.
- b. To ask the Wyandotte Police Department to assist in the clearing of the pier for that date and time.

c. Permission to utilize a portion of the park near the concession stand to have a tent and tables, with a banner to serve as check-in and an eating area for their lunch.

If there are any costs over stated amount in agreement for any city staff/material/property for said event, We Fixin' to Fish will be responsible for those fees no later than 30 days after said event date. Any tents on city property must be weighted (no stakes are allowed to be used to anchor tents) to prevent collapse. Clean up before/during and after the event must be done by We Fixin' to Fish. This event has been reviewed and approved by the Superintendent of Recreation, Superintendent of Public Service, Police Chief and Fire Chief. It is recommended that there is a hold harmless agreement created by the Department of Legal Affairs, the City of Wyandotte added as additional insured to their insurance policy and that the group follow all City of Wyandotte ordinances. DEPARTMENT OF LEGAL AFFAIRS

THE CITY OF WYANDOTTE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Salary for Department of Legal Affairs.

The salary for the law firm of William R. Look, P.C. as the Department of Legal Affairs for the City of Wyandotte shall be at a yearly salary of seventy-five thousand (\$75,000.00) dollars to cover the period from April 20, 2024 to April 19, 2026. In addition, the law firm shall be reimbursed for miscellaneous costs and expenses incurred when acting as legal counsel for the City of Wyandotte. Section 2. Severability.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herein are hereby repealed, only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take immediate effect. This ordinance is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and for providing for the usual daily operation of the city. This ordinance shall be published in a newspaper generally circulated in the City of Wyandotte within ten (10) days after adoption. The ordinance shall designate the location in the city where a true copy of the ordinance can be inspected or obtained. Motion unanimously carried.

2024-129 FINAL READING #1541: AMEND CODE OF ORDINANCE CH. 172 – ELECTRICAL CODE AND INSPECTION

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 172 OF

THE CODE OF ORDINANCES "ELECTRIC CODE AND INSPECTIONS" BY AMENDING ARTICLE § 172.052 "ADOPTION OF ELECTRICAL CODE" AND ARTICLE § 172.072 "QUALIFICATIONS", BY ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE 2023 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE AND THE MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS CONSTRUCTION CODE – PART 8. ELECTRICAL CODE

The City of Wyandotte Ordains:

Section 1. Amend Chapter 172 "Electric Code and Inspections", by amending the following sections: § 172.052 ADOPTION OF ELECTRICAL CODE.

- (A) A certain document, one copy of which is on file in the City Clerk's office, being marked and designated as the 2023 National Electrical Code, is hereby referred to, adopted by the city and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this chapter, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed herein.
- (B) A certain document, one copy of which is on file in the City Clerk's office, being marked and designated as the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Construction Code Part 8 Electrical Code, is hereby referred to, adopted by the city and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this chapter, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed herein.
- (C) The purpose of these codes are the practical safeguarding of persons and property from hazards arising from the use of electricity.
- (D) This adoption of the 2023 National Electric Code and the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Construction Code Part 8 Electrical Code is done in accordance with M.C.L.A. § 117.3(k).

§ 172.072 QUALIFICATIONS.

The person chosen to fill the office of Electrical Inspector shall be a competent, licensed electrician, of good moral character and shall have at least four years' experience as a journeyman in the practice of his or her trade, or two years' training in a recognized college of electrical engineering, and in addition thereto two years of practical experience in electrical construction, shall be well versed in approved methods of electrical construction for safety to life and property, and the rules and regulations issued by the city's Board of Electrical Examiners and Review. He or she shall be familiar with the National Electrical Code, as approved by the National Fire Protection Association, Inc., and other installation and safety rules and standards approved by the 2023 Edition of the National Electrical Code, as approved by

the National Fire Protection Association, Inc., and other installation and safety regulations approved by the Reciprocal Electrical Council, Inc., RECI Manual, including technical amendments to the 2023 Edition of the National Electric Code. The Inspector shall also maintain a file of listed inspected electrical appliance cards issued by or for the Underwriters Laboratories, Incorporated. The Electrical Inspector shall be the electrical inspection authority as described in this chapter. Section 2. Interpretation.

Nothing in this Ordinance or in the Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy or any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 3. Severability.

Severability. Should any word, sentence, phrase or any portion of this Ordinance be held in a manner invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction or by any state agency having authority to do so for any reason whatsoever, such holdings shall be construed and limited to such word, sentence, phrase or any portion of the Ordinance held to be so invalid and shall not be construed as affecting the validity of any of the remaining words, sentences, phrases or portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Conflicting Ordinance.

Conflicting Ordinances. All prior existing ordinances adopted by the City of Wyandotte inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, hereby expressly repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days from the date of its passage by the Wyandotte City Council and a copy of the Ordinance or a summary of said Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper generally circulated in the City of Wyandotte within ten (10) days after adoption. A copy of this ordinance may be inspected or obtained at the City of Wyandotte Clerk's Office, 3200 Biddle Avenue, Wyandotte, Michigan.

Mr. Jensen indicated that it is their plan to demolish the structure, but they do not know the process.

Mr. Mayhew indicated that the city could help. The city received Fire Insurance Withholding Program Funds in the amount of \$15,520 from Ms. Bush's Insurance Company. Mr. Mayhew continued to state that the city could use these funds to demolish the property and any funds remaining would be returned to Ms. Bush.

Mr. Mayhew further indicated that any accessory structures would need to be removed also.

Mr. Mayhew stated that the city would need a letter from Ms. Bush indicating that she wanted the city to proceed with demolition. Mr. Mayhew continued that the letter could come from Ms. Sally Jensen and Mr. Jason Jensen once the Power of Attorney was executed and they were appointed.

Mr. Jensen indicated that would be what they would want to do.

Mr. Mayhew further indicated that there is debris around the home that needs to be cleaned up as soon as possible.

Mr. Jensen indicated that he would take care of the debris as soon as possible.

Mr. Mayhew indicated that if the structure is not removed by the March 31, 2024, the City would remove the home by utilizing the fire escrow funds received by the insurance company in the amount of \$15,520.

The Engineering and Building Department was information that the above captioned property caught on fire on December 7, 2023. An inspection was performed on December 8, 2023, which indicated that the structure was damaged more than 50% of the State Equalized Value. Therefore, in accordance with the City of Wyandotte Property Maintenance Code, Ordinance #1094 the undersigned deems the referenced structure to be dangerous and unsafe and the repairs to be unreasonable. The following are the cited sections of the Property Maintenance Code:

Section 110.1 General: The code official shall order the owner of any premises upon which is located any structure, which in the code official's judgment is so old, dilapidated or has become so out of repair as to be dangerous, unsafe, unsanitary or otherwise unfit for human habitation or occupancy, and such that it is unreasonable to repair the structure, to raze and remove such structure; or if such structure is capable of being made safe by repairs, to repair and make safe and sanitary or to raze and remove at the owner's option; or where there has been a cessation of normal construction of any structure for a period of more than two years, to raze and remove such structure.

<u>Section PM-110.5</u>: Unreasonable repairs: Whenever the code official determines that the cost of such repairs would exceed 50 percent of the current value of such structure, such repairs shall be presumed unreasonable and it shall be presumed for the purpose of this section that such structure is a public nuisance which shall be ordered razed without option on the part of the owner to repair.

Therefore, this Department hereby directs you to raze and remove said structure by. Failure to do so will result in this Department proceeding with Section PM-107.3 Disregard of Notice: Upon refusal or neglect of the person(s) served with the notice to comply with the requirements of the order a Show Cause Hearing shall be held.

To seek a modification of this notice you may request, in writing, that a Show Cause Hearing be held with the undersigned.

PUBLIC HEARING #03182024 – Wyandotte Development, Owner and Appellant, has applied to the Planning Commission for Stage 1 Plan Review for the property at 240 Antoine, Wyandotte, Michigan.

Vice-Chairperson Lupo opened the hearing and asked if there was anyone present who wished to speak about this hearing.

Michael Delly, Owner Wyandotte Development. Mr. Delly indicated that the church will be converted into a multifamily, proposing 16 units, but might go up to 20 units. Mr. Delly further stated that he is going to update the inside and try to keep the outside the way it is.

Mr. Delly indicated that his past project was Dr. Atto's building on Biddle Avenue. Mr. Delly stated that he wants to invest in Wyandotte and make it better.

Commissioner Lupo asked how big of a site is it.

Mr. Delly indicated it was a 16,000 square foot building. Mr. Delly indicted that the units will be one (1) bedroom between 508 and 850 square feet. Mr. Delly further indicated that it would be similar to the St. Elizabeth's Project on Forest Street, that was a church converted to residential apartments.

Commissioner Lupo indicated that those are small units

Mr. Delly indicated that they are one (1) bedroom apartments and it is the best use for the proposed redevelopment of the building.

Commissioner Lupo asked if they were going to do anything to the exterior.

Mr. Delly indicated that he likes the color of the brick and doesn't want to do anything with them. Most of the repairs will be done to the inside.

Commissioner Lupo asked about the church parking lot and if that portion was part of his project

Mr. Delly indicated that he has an agreement with the Archdiocese of Detroit to share the parking lot, but the church and the school properties have been split and his parking spaces are behind his building and it is sufficient parking for his proposed project. Mr. Delly stated further that they will be entering the parking lot from the northside entrance of McKinley.

Commissioner Kowalewski indicated that the property is zoned PD and there is parking right behind the building, which is adequate for the proposed project. Commissioner Kowalewski further stated that if Mr. Delly wants more than 16 units, Mr. Delly would have to reapply to the commission for approval.

Mr. Delly indicated that he wants to do a similar project that was done with St. Elizabeth on Forest Street so he hired the same architect

Maria Talluto, 266 Felice. Ms. Talluto indicated that she lives across the street from the parking lot and 16 units are a lot of small units in one location. Ms. Talluto asked if public funds were being used for this project and why can't they be condos and are they going to be the manager or are they just going to do the project, then sell. Ms. Talluto stated she is not in favor of this project.

Mr. Delly indicated that they would be upscale apartment units and no low income and it is their intent to build and manage the project. Mr. Delly stated further that there is no public funds being used for this project.

Mr. Baughman, 256 Felice. Mr. Baughman indicated that they do not want apartments, they would rather see condos in the building. Mr. Baughman stated further that they can see that there is going to be a parking problem with the small apartments, you could have 36 cars. Mr. Baughman stated this project is not good for the city.

Mr. Baughman continued that there are two (2) houses down the street that are falling down and nothing is being done. Mr. Baughman stated that he does not agree with this proposed project.

Jennifer Charbon, 230 Antoine. Ms. Charbon indicated that she lives next-door and does not want the project. Ms. Charbon continued that there will be problems with the small units and added that the building currently is not being maintained and does not want to see 16 units in that location.

Commissioner Kowalewski asked what is separation between the two properties.

Ms. Charbon indicated that there is a chain-link fence separating the properties.

Ms. Baughman, 256 Felice. Ms. Baughman indicated that she lives across the street and stated that the fence and the parking lot are both falling apart and not being maintained and that there will be a big problem with parking, when the church is being used, the parking lot is already full and then you add the 16 tenants there will be an even bigger parking problem.

Mr. Delly indicated that he did not know there were broken windows and he will go over to the building and make sure everything is safe. Mr. Delly indicated that the one (1) bedroom apartment will be nice upscale units and does not foresee any issues with parking.

Commissioner Williams asked if there was a separation between the lots physically.

Mr. Delly indicated that they are legally separated, but he can put cement blocks up to separate the parking lots.

Planning Commission Meeting April 18, 2024

Commissioner Williams indicated that he feels a sign for tenant parking would stop any confusion for parking.

Mr. Delly indicated that he would not be opposed to that.

Commissioner Kowalewski asked what Mr. Delly's plan is on the east property line to separate from the residential home.

Mr. Delly indicated that he would put up whatever the commission would like but at this time he has no plans for any changes.

Commissioner Kowalewski indicated that Mr. Delly be prepared to indicate exactly what type of solid screen fence he will be construction of the east property line when his hearing is before the City Council.

Mr. Delly indicated that he would not be opposed to that.

Commissioner Kowaleski further indicated that he does not feel parking blocks are going to be a sufficient designation between the two parking lots of the church and Mr. Delly's property.

Mr. Delly indicated that he would not be opposed to a landscape area for separation, but he would have to check to make sure it did not cause any loss of parking.

Commissioner Kowalewski asked Mr. Delly if he had an easement agreement with the church.

Mr. Delly indicated that he did.

Pedro Oliva, 239 Antoine. Mr. Oliva indicated that he lives across the street and he does not want to see the building be redeveloped into 16 units. Mr. Oliva stated that he feels the neighborhood would lose its peacefulness and there will be parking issues. Mr. Oliva feels that it will be rundown and not kept up. Mr. Oliva indicted that he would rather see the property demolished and two new homes be built there. Mr. Oliva is against this project.

Commissioner Schultz reviewed the PD process and indicated that the Planning Commission will make a recommendation to City Council and then City Council ultimately approve it or deny the proposed project.

Ms. Jonna Brookshire, 1256 5th St. Ms. Brookshire indicated that she does not live in the area, but her kids ride their bike to the park, that is not far from this development and she thinks this development is not a good idea. Ms. Brookshire stated it will cause more traffic in the neighborhood and it will not be safe for her kids and she against the project.

There being no further discussion, the hearing was closed.

No communications were received regarding this request.



Mr. Sladovnik indicated that it is not a tattoo parlor. The tenants Cathy Sellars and Aleka Sauve, submitted a letter indicating what microblading is, which is attached to these minutes.

Planning Commission Meeting April 18, 2024

Mr. Sladovnik indicted that he is not sure that he wants to rezone his property, but he just wants the microblading use to be allowed.

Commissioner Kowalewski explained the process that needs to be followed for the microblading use and that the first step is to apply for rezoning and if that is denied than the tenant can apply to the Zoning Board of Appeals for a use variance. Commissioner Kowalewski indicated that if the rezoning is allowed then the microblading would be allowed.

Commissioner Schultz indicated that the request for rezoning would be considered spot zoning, which the commission is not fond of.

Commissioner Williams asked if the use for microblading required any additional approvals.

Ms. Sauve indicated that she will need to get licensed through Wayne County Health Department.

Commissioner Lupo asked if Wayne County inspected the property.

Ms. Sauve indicated yes, once a year.

Commissioner Lupo asked what the hours would be.

Ms. Sauve indicated that it would be by appointment only.

There being no further discussion, the hearing was closed.

One (1) communication was received from the proposed tenant.

Microblading, ombré brows, and combo brows are three different styles of cosmetic permanent makeup that I am trained and certified by the state of Michigan. Microblading, by definition is considered an indelable mark made upon the body of another individual by the insertion of pigment under the skin, the state law considers this tattooing by definition.

Each eyebrow I create is designed specifically for each individual based on their bone structure, facial muscles, and skin type. All three of the above eyebrow styles are done with semipermanent ink, which fades over time to allow for adjustments as the skin and face change throughout the years. These cosmetic services are a great comfort to

anyone dealing with scarcity in the eyebrow region. This service is offered to people that may be having an experience that leaves minimal options for a healthy eyebrow appearance, In my experience I have personally helped many people dealing with alopecia, cancer, and other forms of hair loss regain their confidence by giving them their eyebrows back. Just a recap that microblading is considered an idelable mark left on the body by inserting pigment under the skin which is also known as tattooing, I my field we call it microblading.

I respectfully ask that you allow this service to be conducted at Luxe Studios by approving or adding the zoning requirements needed to allow my skill to operate business with the downtown district
