ART is one of the earliest creative images representing the Wyandotte Street Art Fair. ART's likeness was found on an early Street Art Fair poster in the archival collections of the Wyandotte Museums.

When ART first made his debut in Wyandotte, the year was 1964 and Street Art Fair was only three years old. The Fair, created by the Acanthus Art Society, quickly became a much anticipated favorite summer-time event.
