- The forums will be held at the following locations on the specified dates and times. There will be a one hour general presentation followed by an application workshop.

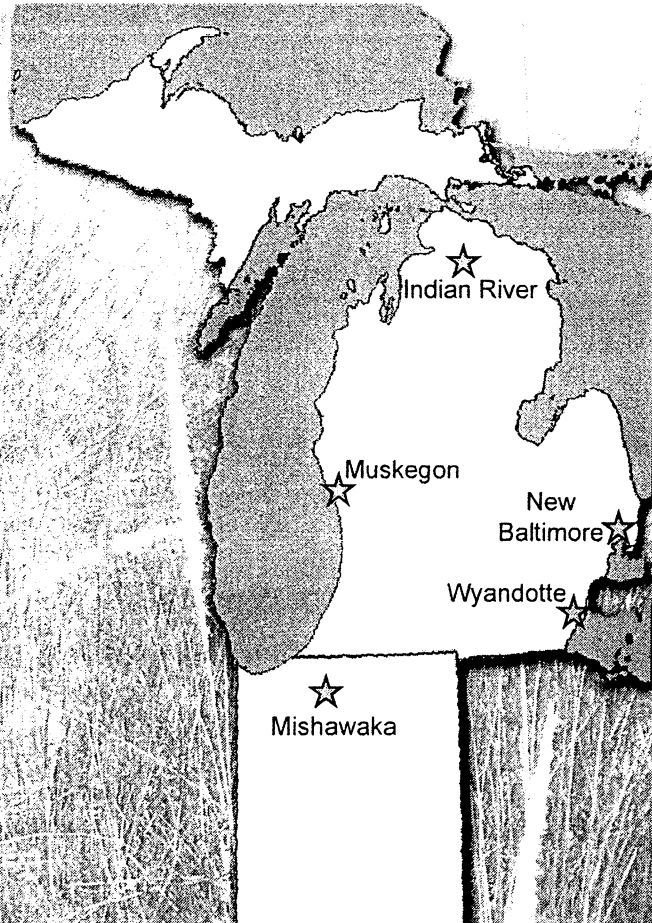
